Evaluation of new and existing products utilizing methods and tools common to general scientific, mathematical or engineering principles.
<u>Intellectual Property (IP) Ownership & Licensing Rights</u>	WSU owns IP. Company receives opportunity to license resulting IP.	Company pays fee to have exclusive rights to license for Project IP for a set time. After this time, the Company can elect to extend exclusive rights, convert to a non-exclusive license or non-renew the license.	WSU owns Project IP; but, Improvements to Company background IP belongs to Company. Company pays fee to have exclusive rights to license Project Intellectual Property.	Test results are owned by Company.
<u>Publication</u>	Results of research are ordinarily published and shared broadly throughout the scientific community. Company has right of review, prior to dissemination, for its proprietary information.			WSU may issue publications based on Testing Services & non-proprietary Company results for research and educational purposes. Company has right of review, prior to dissemination, for its proprietary information.
